THE MAGISTRATE: The 78th District Court is now on record with File Number 14-2889-FY, the defendant's name is Matthew Wayne Jones, and Paul Michael Jones, being charged with count one, co-defendants, homicide - murder -- murder first degree premeditated. Here to swear on the complaint is Detective Rios.

Mr. Rios, can you please raise your right hand?

Do you solemnly swear, attest, and affirm that the information in these documents is the truth to the best of your knowledge and information, so help you God?

DETECTIVE RIOS: I do.

SCOTT RIOS

sworn by the Magistrate at 3:53 p.m., testified as follows:

DETECTIVE RIOS: Your Honor, on July 17th, 1989,
Robert Siders, the father of Shannon Siders, left work
approximately 10:30 p.m. Shannon was left at home at that
time. On July 18th, 1989, when Robert Siders returned home,
Shannon was not there. He eventually reported her missing
on July 20th, 1989.

On October 15th of 1989, Shannon's body was discovered in Brooks Township, Newaygo County, by a bow hunter.

An autopsy was conducted by Doctor Graeser, who was the medical examiner at the time, who indicated the cause of

death was blunt force trauma to the head, and the manner of death is homicide. There were also mul -- multiple other injuries.

Investigators started to work on this case at that time, at -- at the time, and Detective/Sergeant Miller, along with other investigators, were able to determine that Shannon Siders on July 17th, had met up with Norm Shields, Billie Shields, Clint Guthrie, Ricky Gomez, Michelle Burns, Darrin Sackett, Paul Jones and Matt Jones.

On July 18th, at 1:30 a.m., a witness reported that Shannon stopped by her house to pick up a cassette tape. Also on July 18th, Shannon was last scene riding with a Matt and Paul Jones, leaving the Grant area, headed towards Newaygo.

A witness reported that they observed the Jones vehicle turning eastbound on 88th from M-37, which is the direction which Shannon's body was recovered. That vehicle was -- in the vehicle was Paul Jones, and Matt Jones, and Shannon Siders.

Pat -- Paul Jones initial interview -- initial interview indicated that they had dropped Shannon off between 12:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. There were two separate witnesses that indicated they went to Shannon's residence several times up to 3:00 a.m. in the morning, however, she was not home.

Two additional witnesses came across Paul Jones and another male introduced as his brother not far from the area where Shannon's body was located. And Paul asked the witness if they saw a female walking around. Just prior to daylight, the same two witnesses came across the same vehicle being driven by Paul Jones and — were occupied by Paul Jones and Matt Jones on a two-track. As they approached, they could see a female laying on the ground and Paul Jones standing over Shannon Siders. The witness exited his vehicle and approached, tripped and fell to the ground. Paul Jones kicked the witness in the face. Another male subject walking behind the vehicle, holding some type of tool.

A witness observed Paul Jones then grab Shannon and dragged her back towards their vehicle. The two witnesses described Shannon as limp and blood on her face. The area in which the witnesses observed Paul, and Matt, and the limp body of Shannon, were just east of the location where her body was discover -- discovered in a pine row.

Detective/Sergeant Miller described these rows as approxi -- described these pines as approximately 10 feet high, 10 feet tall, I'm sorry. The area is known as the hole in the woods. A location in which witnesses observed Paul, and Matt, and Shannon were in close proximity, and fairly accessible via two-tracks.

An independent witness from that area reported hearing screams in the area the same night in which the two previous witnesses observed Paul and Matt.

Over the years, Paul has made various statements indicating he ran her -- ran her over. Face it, she's dead. They were overheard talking to another individual and indicated they hit her with a mirror and then began to beat and rape her. They told witnesses they didn't know -- didn't remember what happened that night.

Paul Jones also told another witness he last saw Shannon walking down -- walking together down a row of pines with Matt.

Another witness, Paul indicated that they were at a party and they left prior to Shannon. Matt has made multiple statements as well. He also was involved with talking to a witness indicating that he hit Shannon with a mirror and they began to beat and rape her.

Told another witness -- witness they came out of the house and Shannon, I'm sorry, they went to a house and as Shannon came out of the house, a male was following her and yelling at her. They went to a party, and Shannon got out of the car and left with somebody.

Another witness statement that Matt Jones indicated that she got into the car with some Mexicans and left. And another witness yet indicated that Matt stated

they met Shannon at a party and left without her.

Subsequently, the last two known individuals to be with Shannon were Matt Jones and Paul Jones. Two witnesses observed Paul Jones and the other individual with him, later identified as Matt Jones, Paul Jones standing over the limp body of Shannon Siders.

Subsequently requested -- I'm requesting two warrants, one for each individual for first degree murder.

THE MAGISTRATE: The Court finds probable cause and will issue this complaint and warrant. Do you have any concerns with bond in this matter?

DETECTIVE RIOS: I do, your Honor. There's -- both these individuals have been known to leave the area when being confronted by law enforcement. Neither individual has a steady job. Neither has a permanent residence. However, they do have family in the area.

In the last three years, Matt Jones has changed residence during the course of this cold case investigation at least three times. Matt Jones has also contacted a number of the witnesses involved in this particular -- involved in this case.

Investigators learned that there are unreported sexual assault incidents in 1989 with Matt. Skip -- like I indicated earlier, sir, Matt Jones is unemployed. Normally -- he's currently working through Manpower, a temp service.

He'd also failed to report in 1998 for a traffic D-W-L-S. Failed to appear in court in 1996 for traffic offenses. And in 1990, failed to show in court.

For Paul Jones, after the body was found, Paul moved out of the area. Later moving back to the Newaygo area. Paul was arrested and convicted and spent time in prison for home invasion.

During the course of this home invasion, he had what I'll describe as a rape kit with him in 2006, which included duct tape, condoms, and vaseline, and a stun gun.

Paul -- Paul Jones is a drug user, having recently been arrested and convicted for marijuana. He's also lived at multiple addresses since being released in prison in 2011.

In 2012, when investigators spoke with Paul Jones, he left the state of Michigan and went to Texas. He's currently back in Michigan. Paul Jones, again, is unemployed and has an unsteady unemployment. He's currently living in the basement of somebody else's house, and does not own a residence in this area.

THE MAGISTRATE: Any consideration or bond conditions regarding the witnesses in this matter, sir?

DETECTIVE RIOS: I would request no contact with any of the witnesses. I didn't name the witnesses.

THE MAGISTRATE: Do -- do they have C-I numbers

possibly to keep their identity safe?

DETECTIVE RIOS: I do not. I do not have those.

THE MAGISTRATE: Well the Court is going to set -is not going to -- is going to deny pre-trial release,
based on the nature of the charge and the possibility of
them leaving this jurisdiction. Bond condition orders will
be, if you can get the Court the confidential in -- confidential information so the Court can put a bond condition
of no contact with those -- those victims just in case they
-- they were to bond out or to get out.

DETECTIVE RIOS: Thank you, your Honor.

THE MAGISTRATE: I guess you won't have to put a bond condition on them because I'm denying their pre-trial release.
